Equity

Eliminate transportation burdens across all communities, particularly low-income communities, communities of color, and people with disabilities

Objectives:

Improve transportation-related economic, environmental, and public health outcomes for current and historically disadvantaged communities

Improve access to a range of high-quality, safe, and affordable mobility options within current and historically disadvantaged communities

Support current and historically disadvantaged communities in playing an active and direct role in transportation decision making

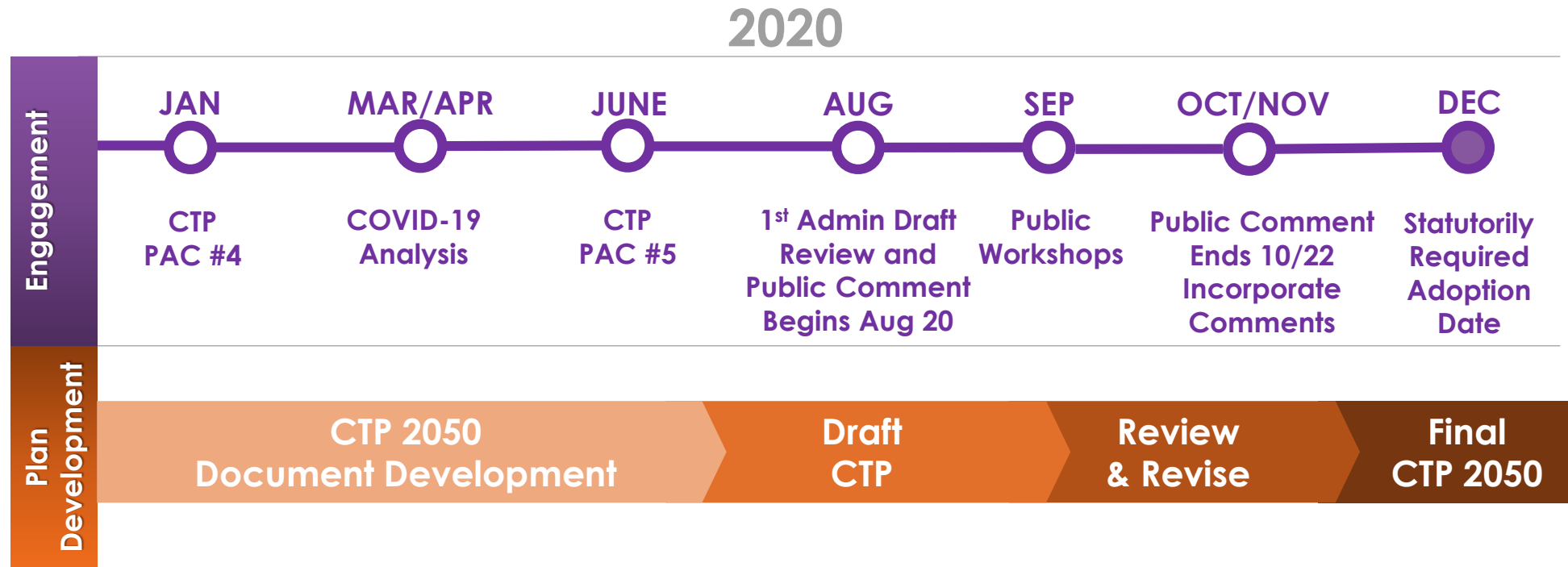
CTP 2050 COVID Response

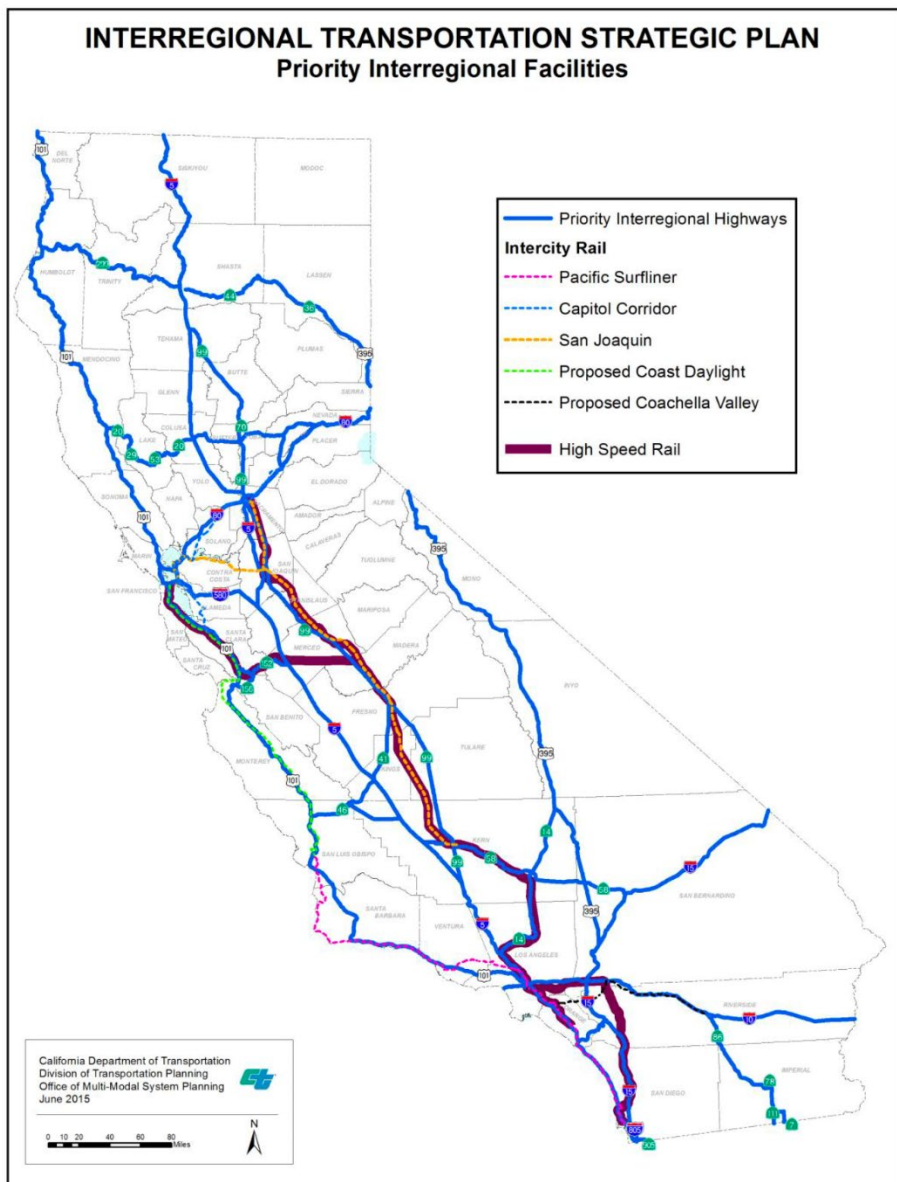
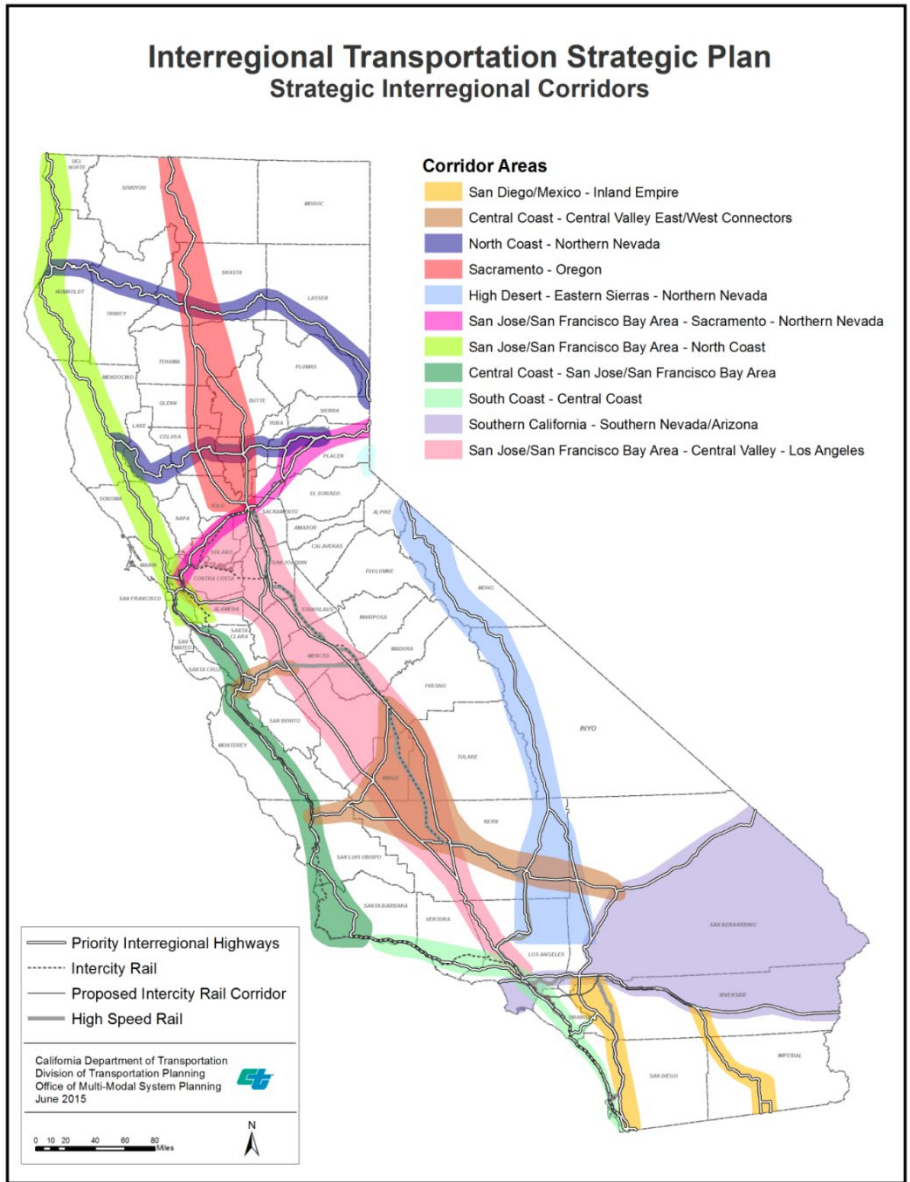


Background



- ◆ 1998 – First Interregional Transportation Plan (ITSP) was developed
 - ◆ *Focused on improving the movement of people, vehicles, and goods*
 - ◆ *Provide guidance and prioritization to Interregional Transportation Improvement Program (ITIP) for Caltrans*
- ◆ 2015 – ITSP updated to be consistent with CTP 2040
 - ◆ *Identified 11 Strategic Interregional Corridors and Priority Interregional Facilities*
 - ◆ *Considered short, medium, and long-term interregional needs on the facilities identified in the 11 Corridors using ITIP and other potential program funds.*

2015 Strategic Interregional Corridors and Facilities



Vision

- ◆ The ITSP will:
 - ◆ *Provide a framework on how it will implement the goals and objectives laid out in the CTP 2050 along Executive Order N-19-19.*
 - ◆ *Continue to provide guidance and prioritization through interregional corridor analysis for projects focused improving interregional movement for people and goods on the State's Transportation System*
