



G-12 Progress Report through September 2020

- G-12's represent delegated authority to make adjustments (increases or decreases) to project funding.
- Through September 2020, Caltrans has processed the following changes:
 - SHOPP: Approximately \$37 million in increases from 22 projects, and \$84 million in savings from 56 projects.
 - STIP: \$188,000 in savings from one project.



Two Year Gasoline Consumption Trends




Notes: Orange indicates estimated monthly consumption based on gross gasoline excise tax revenue deposits.
