## **ATP Fund Estimate Development**

- Resources
  - Assumes no change to State funding levels
  - Federal funding include estimates from the new Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act
  - Obligation Authority received assumed at 95 percent of Apportionments
- Adjustments
  - Excludes previously programmed revenues and resources reserved for the 2025 ATP Fund Estimate
