

History: From Neighborhood to Highway










Background

- May 2017 Metro Board approves motion adopting the Transportation System Management / Transportation Demand Management (TSM / TDM) as the Locally Preferred Alternative for the proposed SR-710 North Study
- November 2018 Caltrans releases Final EIR / EIS identifying TSM / TDM as the preferred alternative
- September 2019 Senate Bill 7 and Assembly Bill 29 Legislation

SR 710 North Stub Area






Roadmap to Relinquishment
