

2021 ITSP


ADOPTED OCTOBER 2021

2022 Addendum


- Maintains the facility designations, goals, and strategies from the 2021 ITSP

Example: Freight Truck Parking

SACRAMENTO – OREGON CORRIDOR

- Caltrans 2021 Statewide Truck Parking Data
- Truck parking limited through the North State
- Safety concerns with parking on highway shoulders and local roads



Example: Rail Integration

CENTRAL COAST – BAY AREA CORRIDOR


- Central Coast rail and High Speed Rail connect at San Jose station
- Transit connections to Gilroy and Tulare are needed to improve HSR access for Central Coast




Example: Alternate Fuel Stations

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA – ARIZONA CORRIDOR

- Large disparity between rural and urban communities
- Pattern likely to be repeated with truck charging and fueling stations
