Climate Action Plan for Transportation Infrastructure (CAPTI)

- Governor's Executive Order N-19-19 directs CalSTA to leverage state transportation spending to meet climate goals.
- CAPTI is a holistic framework for aligning state infrastructure investments with climate, health, and equity goals.
- The plan includes 10 Guiding Principles, 8 Strategies, and 34 actions to create a vision and plan for prioritizing state transportation investments.



CAPTI Annual Progress Report

CAPTI Strategy 8 calls for a **CAPTI Annual Report** on implementation progress to be released annually.

Annual Report includes:

- A status of each action
- Highlights of key successes
- Preliminary discussion of data and metrics

Annual Report does not include:

- An update to the CAPTI Framework or strategies
- New actions or removal of existing actions
