



G-12 Progress Report through October 2022

- G-12's represent delegated authority to make adjustments (increases or decreases) to project funding.
- Through October 2022, Caltrans has processed the following changes:
 - SHOPP: Approximately \$29 million in increases from 47 projects, and \$23 million in savings from 55 projects.
 - STIP: An \$883,500 increase from one project, and \$900 in savings from one project.
