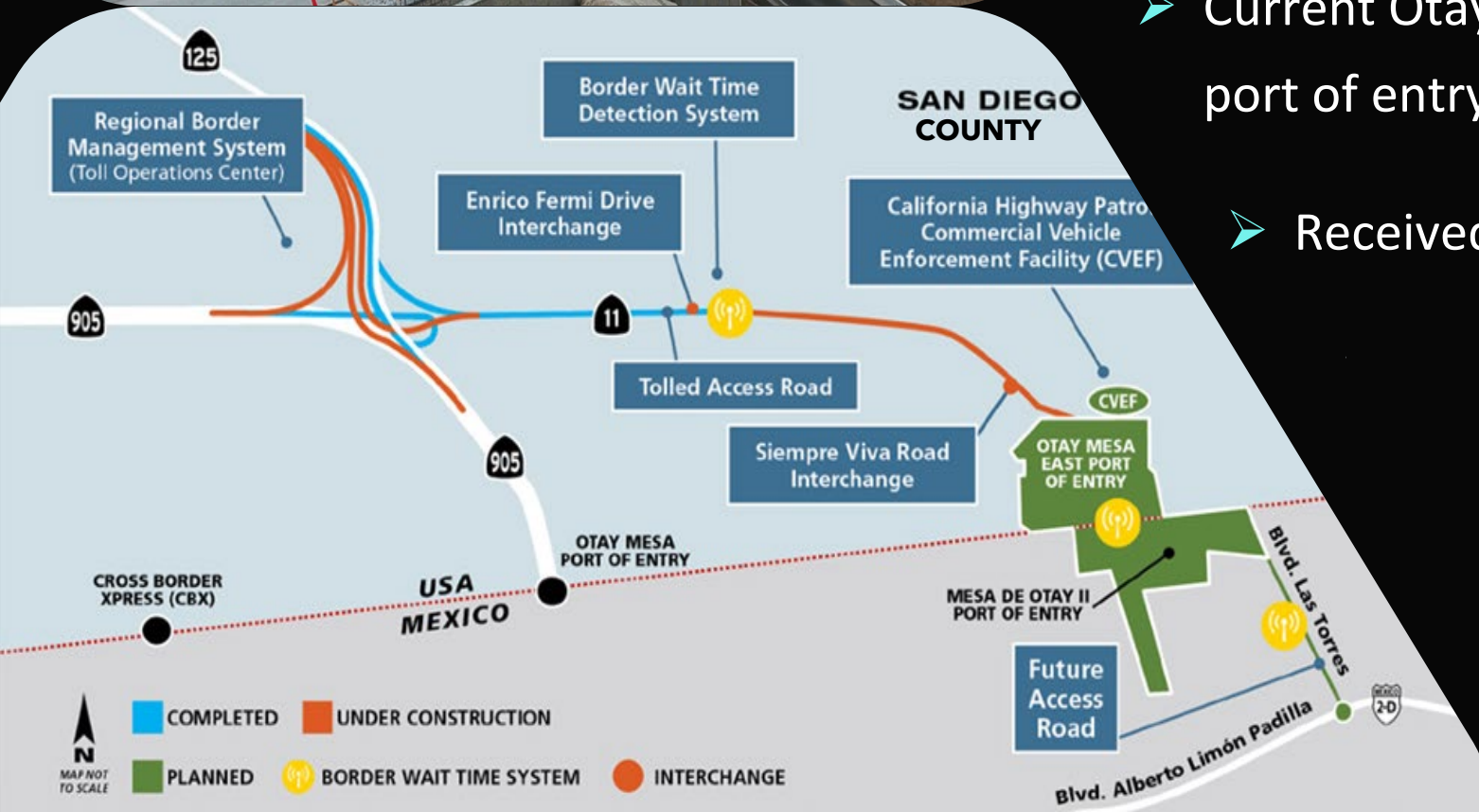

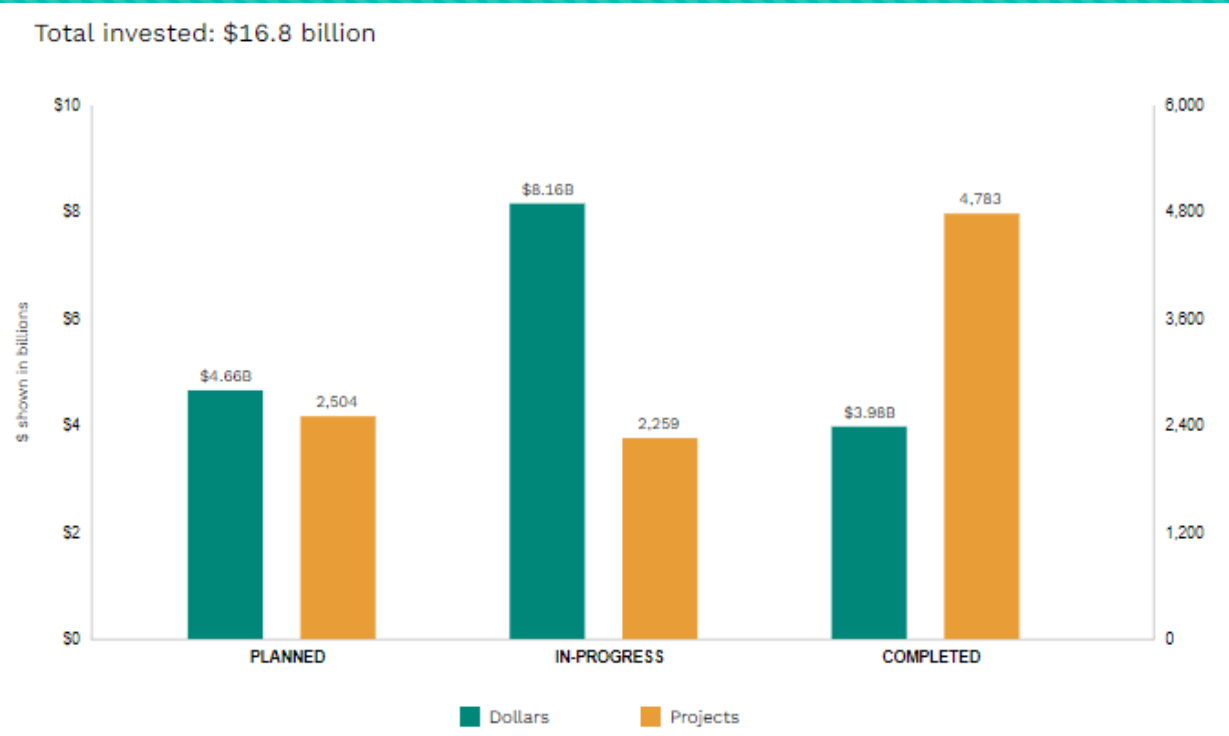
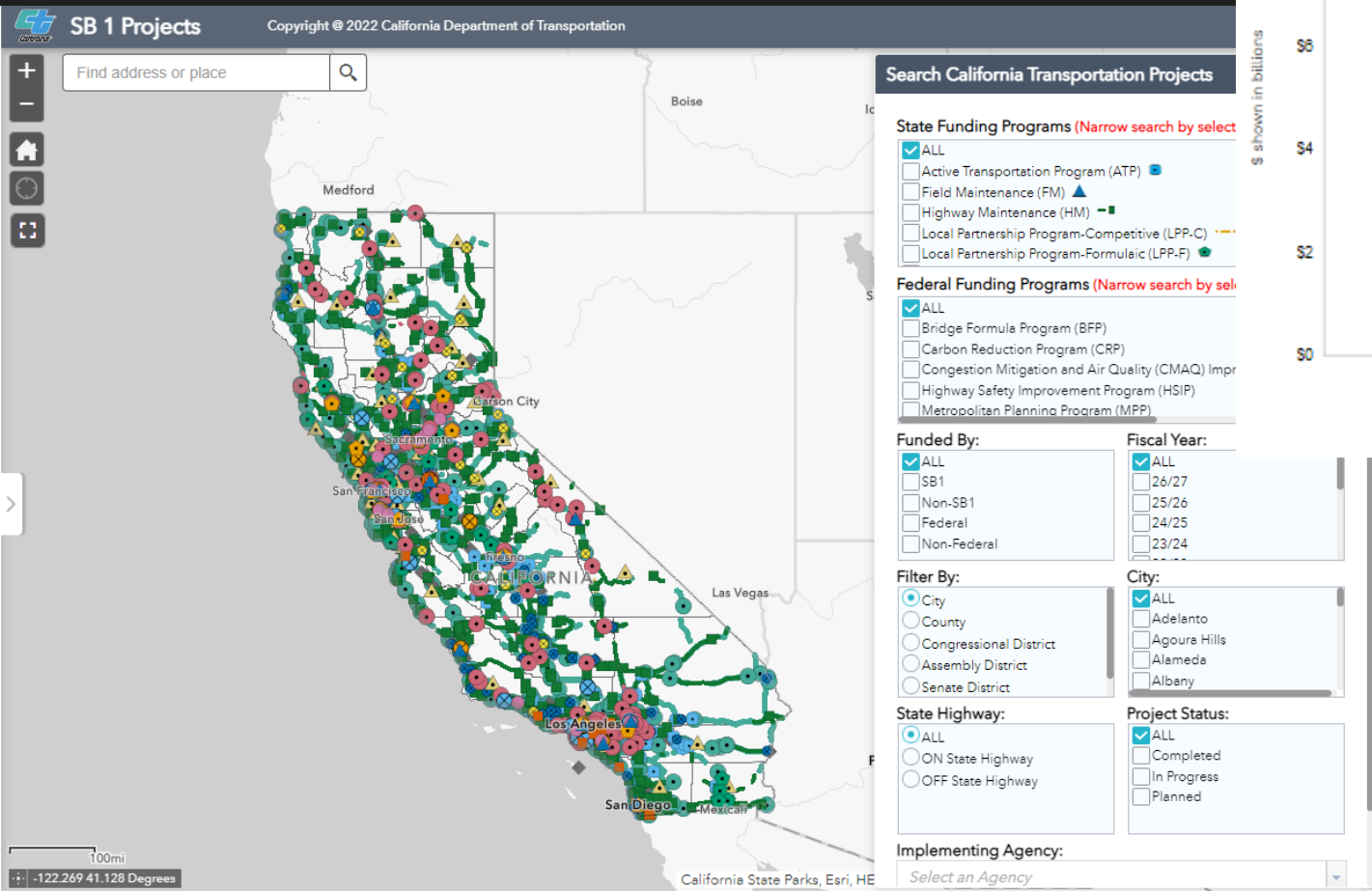

# Highway 99 Bridges

Fixed 5 Bridges in and near Elk Grove along SR 99.  
Construction Manager/General Contractor (CMGC) project.

## Elk Grove

### COSUMNES RIVER BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

**Location:** State Route 99, south of Elk Grove, mile marker 7.1-9.4

**Governing agency:** Caltrans

**Construction cost:** \$158M

**McConnell Underpass/Overhead:** A new overpass will be built so both lanes of SR 99 will go over the railroad track.

**Cosumnes River Bridge:** Northbound and southbound bridges will be replaced with one bridge for all four lanes of traffic.

**Cosumnes River Overflow Bridge:** Northbound and southbound bridges will be replaced with one bridge for all four lanes of traffic.

# HOV Lanes in Carpinteria



- 5.8 lane miles of HOV lanes in each direction
- 4 out of 11 reconstructed bridges to date
