

G-12 Progress Report through January 2023

- G-12's represent delegated authority to make adjustments (increases or decreases) to project funding.
- Through January 2023, Caltrans has processed the following changes:
 - SHOPP: Approximately \$56 million in increases from 85 projects, and \$75 million in savings from 110 projects.
 - STIP: Approximately \$3 million in increases from two projects, and \$900 in savings from one project.
