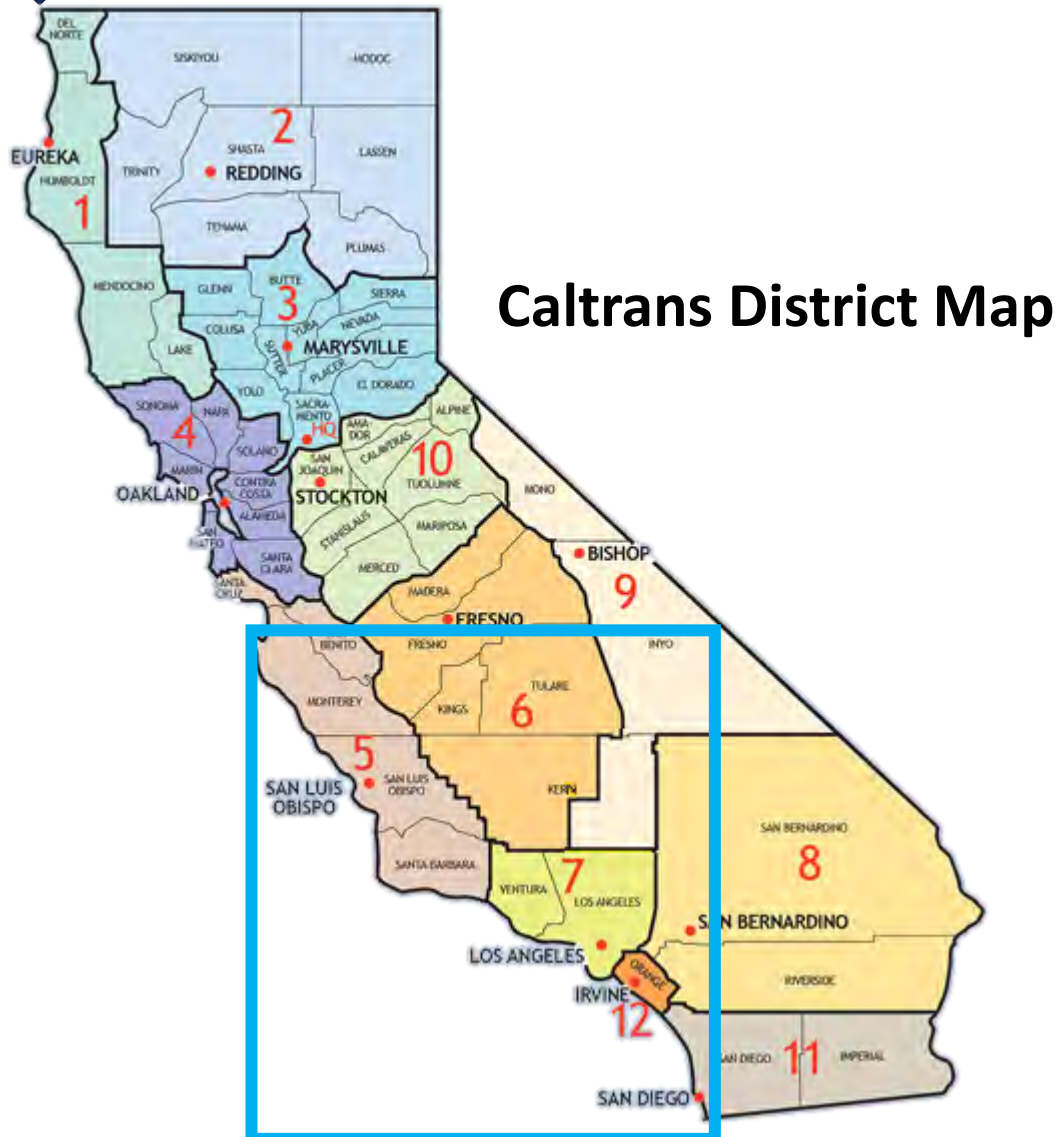

# Central Avenue Bike Lanes in Camarillo



The project will **construct Class II bike lanes** on both sides of **Central Avenue**, a high traffic volume arterial street, starting at the City limits and extending to the US-101 Freeway Northbound off-ramp.



The project will **close a missing link in the region's east-west bikeway network** on Central Avenue also providing **safer travel for students** commuting to Rio Mesa High School
