 - Fiscal years 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24, and 2024-25
- Anticipate similar funding availability as last cycle: \$445,560
 - \$100,000 fiscal years 2021-22 and 2022-23
 - \$122,780 fiscal years 2023-24 and 2024-25

Commission Staff Proposed **Guidelines** Revisions:

- **Beginning with the 2023 Active Transportation Program, nominated projects that are included in an adopted active transportation plan or similar plan will be awarded points. Commission staff intend to develop the criteria for these points in consultation with the ATP workgroup during the guideline development process for the 2023 Active Transportation Program. (pg. 15)**

Scoring Rubric Revision Highlights:

- Clarified Language and Removed Duplicative Language
- Defined when Extreme Scoring is Appropriate
- Added Scoring on New Policy Areas
- Commission Staff Scores DAC Location and Severity
- Evaluators Score Leverage

ATP 2021 Workshop



Scoring Rubric Revision Highlights:

- Emphasized the Importance of Attachments/Supporting Materials
- Explained that Answers to Part Bs should relate to Part As
- Clarified Scoring on Alternative Safety Data
- Defined Engagement vs. Outreach
- Defined Scope and Plan Layout Consistency Scoring
