

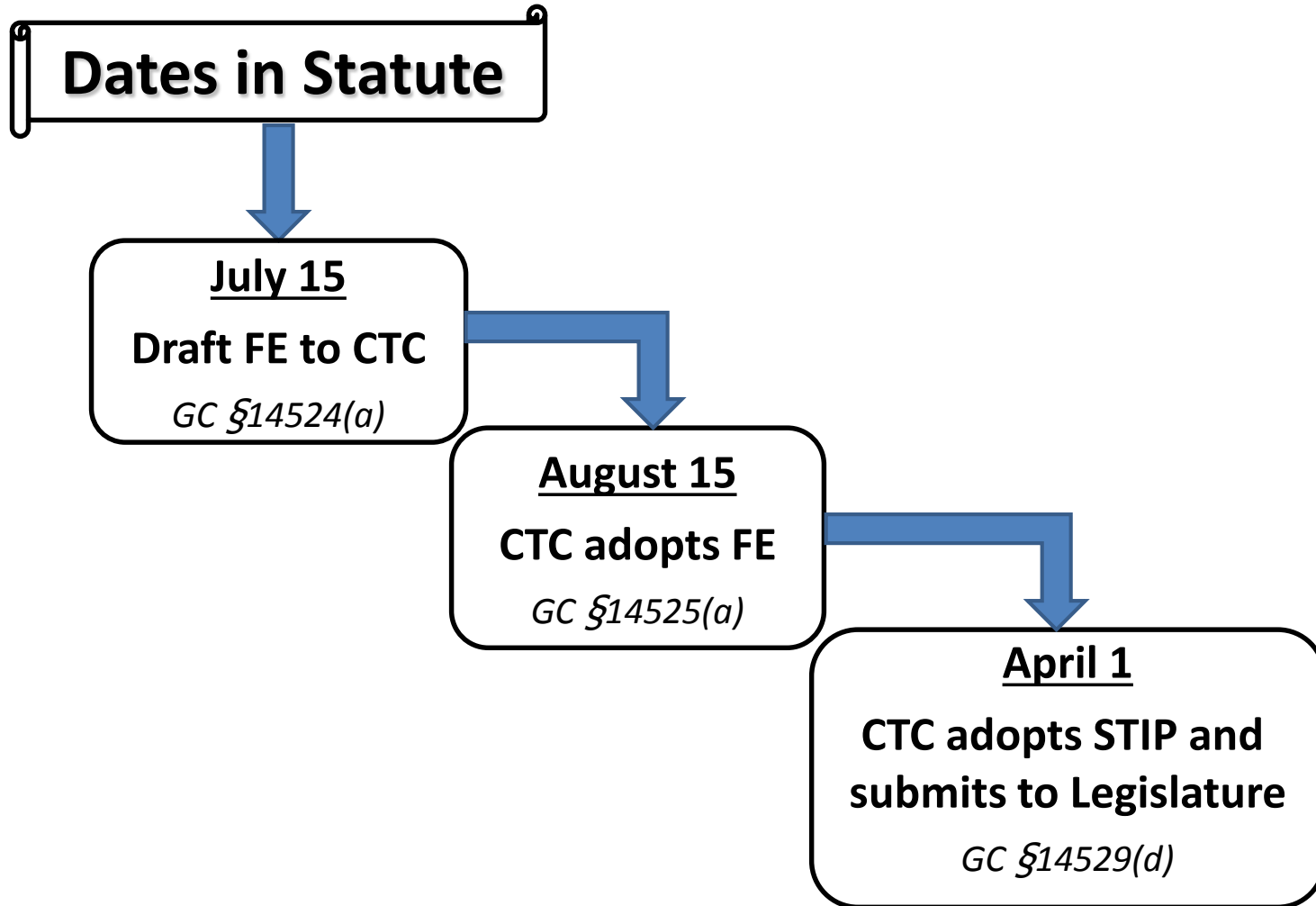


# 2018 STIP Fund Estimate Overview and Schedule Adoption

# What is the Fund Estimate (FE)?

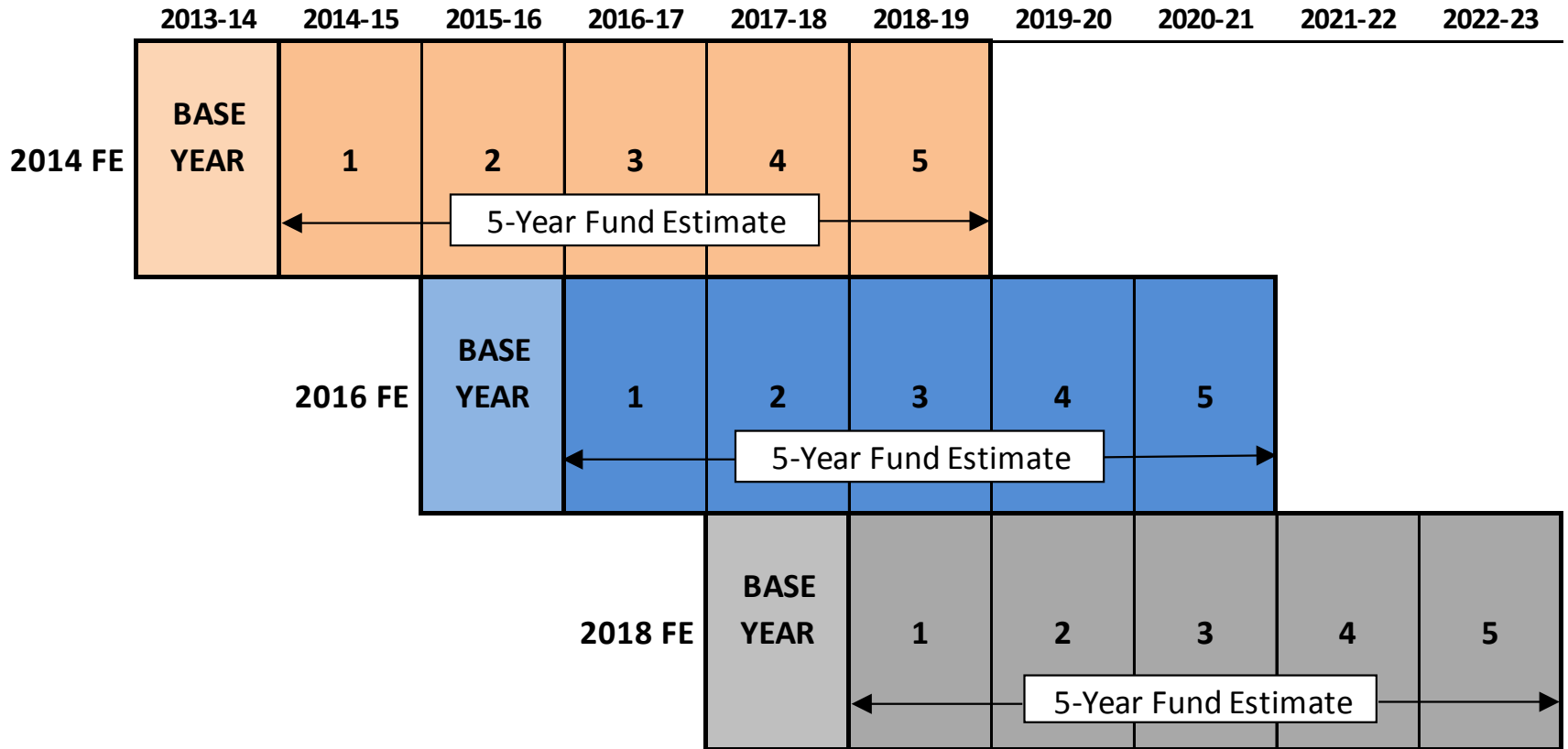
- **Five year projection of available resources**
  - Required by statute
  - Prepared biennially
  - Estimates State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) and State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) capacity
- **Role of the California Transportation Commission**
  - Provides guidance on the FE
  - Adopts FE in August of each odd-numbered year
  - Adopts STIP consistent with FE
  - Submits STIP by April 1 of each even-numbered year

\*Government Code (GC) §14525(d) allows for delay and amendment of FE

# Statutory Guidance

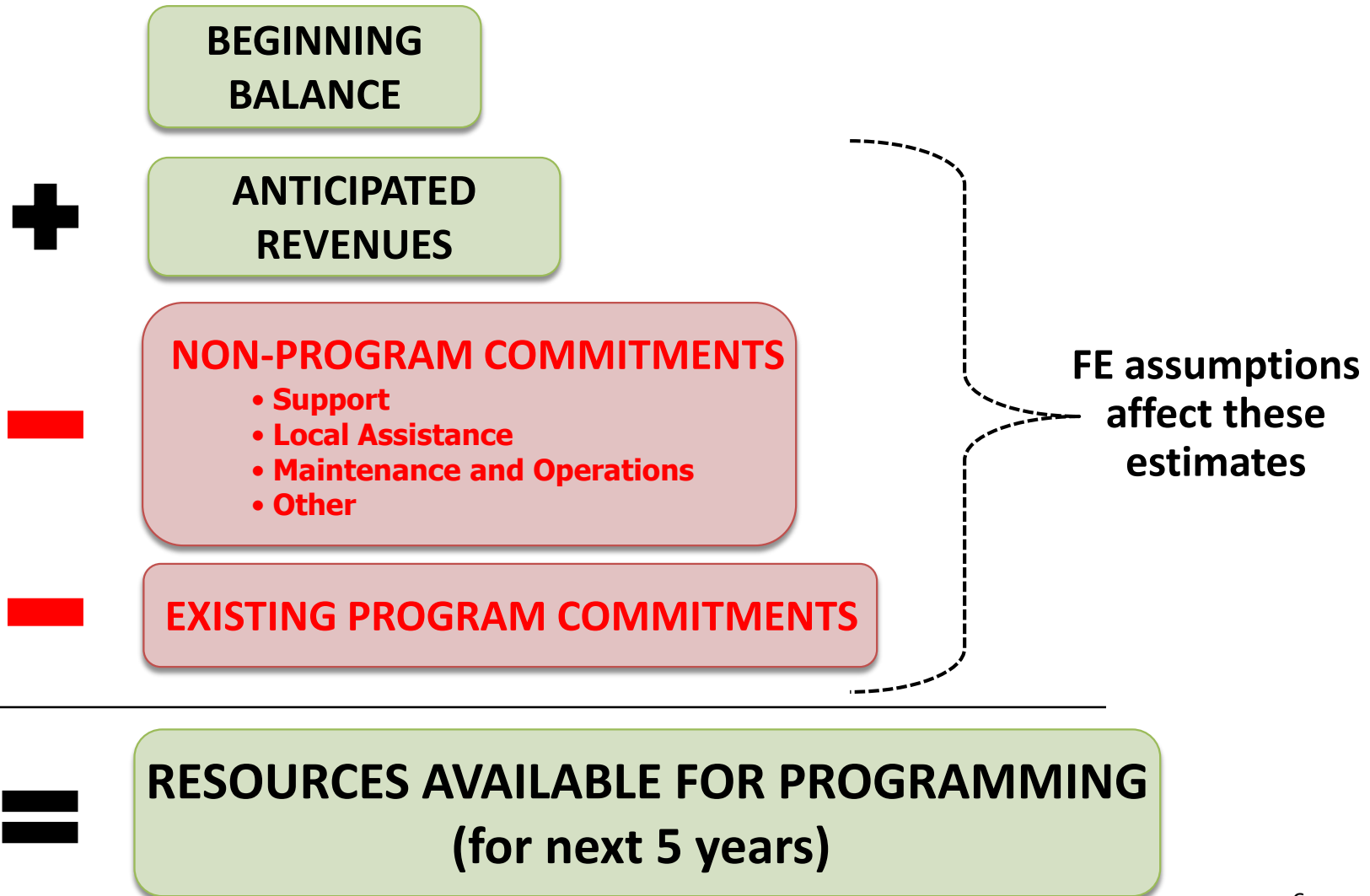
## ● Revenues

- Must assume no changes in “existing state and federal statutes” per Government Code (GC) §14524(c)

## ● Expenditures

- Per Street and Highways Code (SHC):
  - Administrative - §163(a)
  - Maintenance and Operations - §163(b)
  - SHOPP - §163(c)
  - Local assistance - §163(d)
  - STIP - §163(e)

# Timeline and Schedule Adoption

Date	Objective
March 15	Draft FE Assumptions presented to Commission
May 17	FE Assumptions approval by Commission
June 28	Draft of FE presented to Commission
August 16	Final FE adoption by Commission

- August Commission meeting is scheduled to occur after the adoption date indicated in statute
  - Department recommends the Commission adopt Resolution G-17-01 authorizing delay of FE adoption per GC §14525 (d).
