The Pilot Program by the Numbers



Pilot breakdown:

- 9 month pilot period
- 5,000+ participating vehicles
 - 4,498 private vehicles
 - 55 heavy commercial trucks
 - 258 light commercial trucks
- 6 different reporting methods
 - 81% using an automated method
 - 19% using a manual method

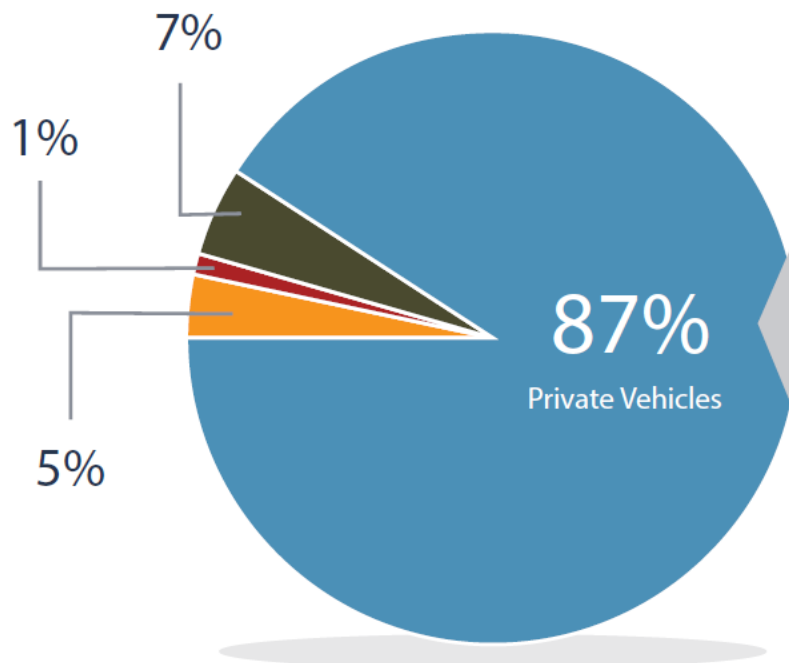

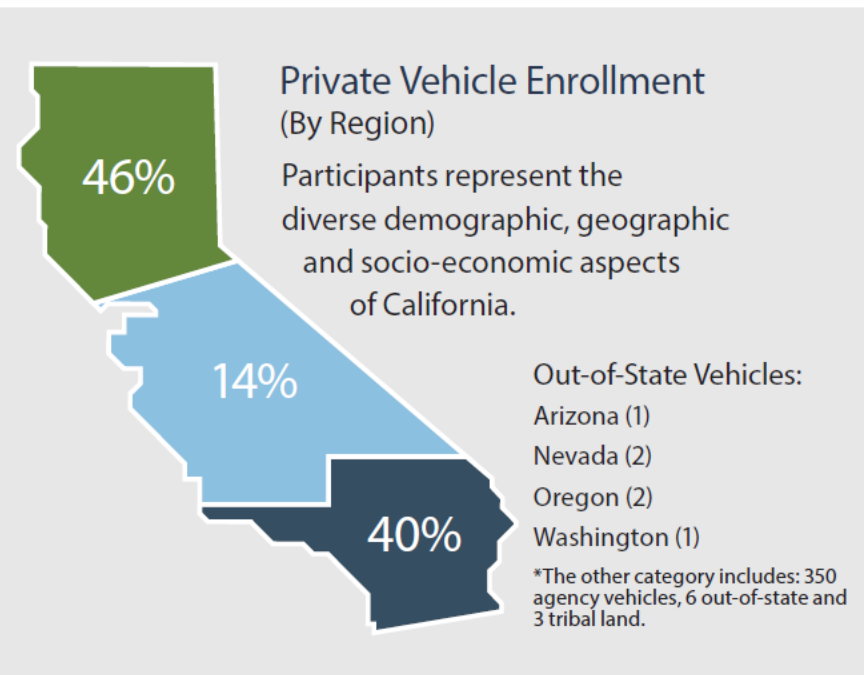

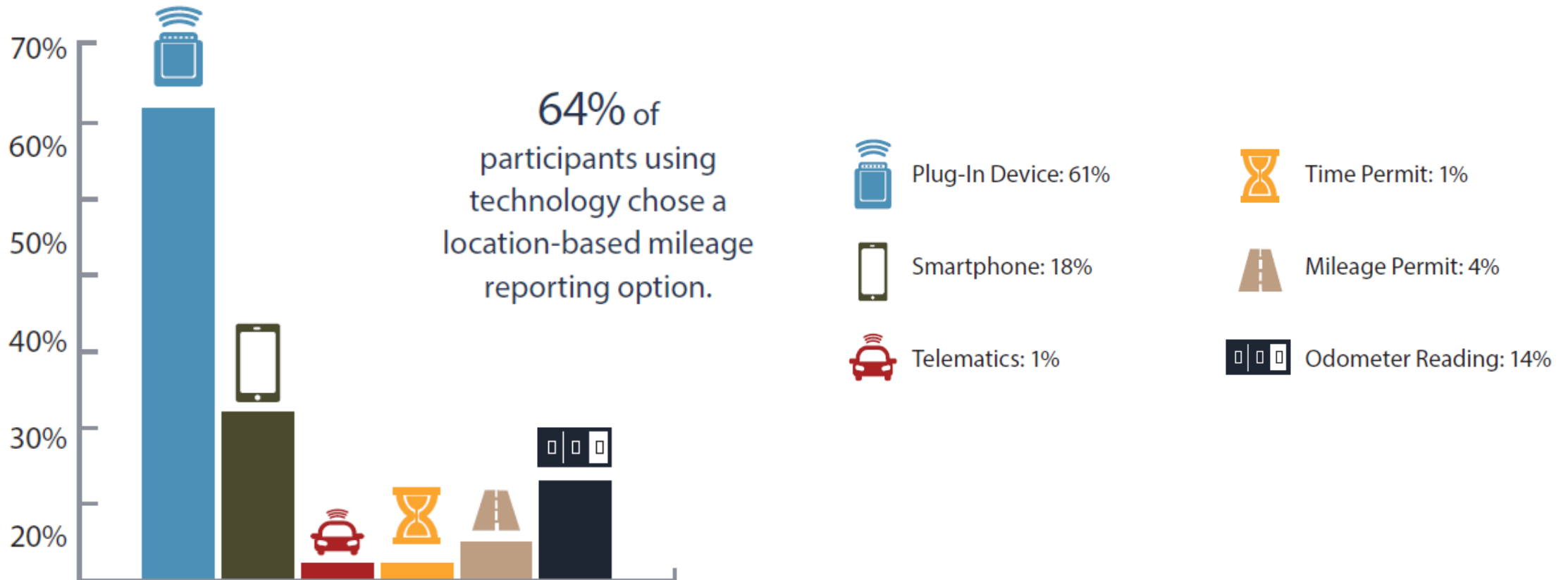

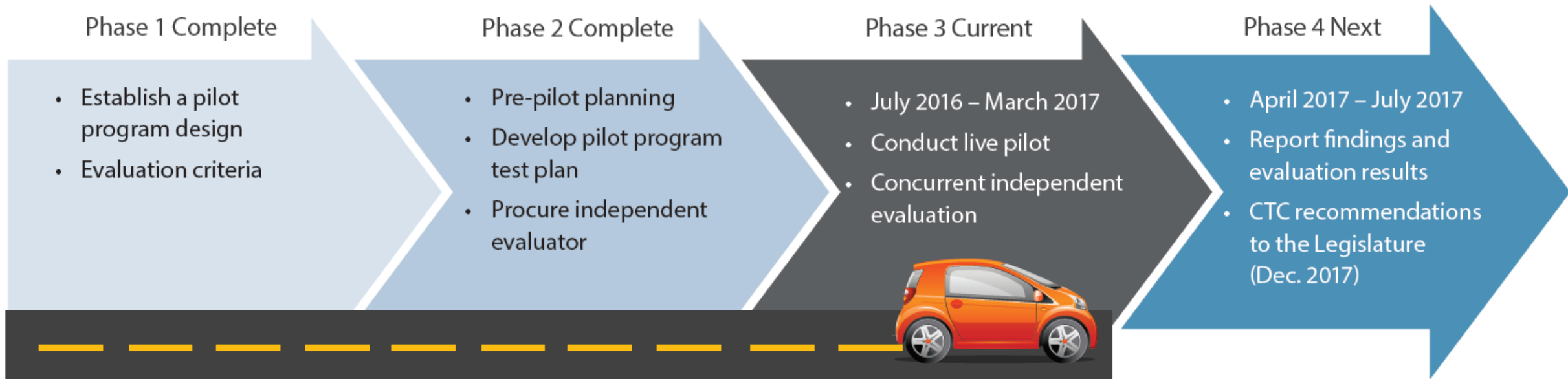


Survey results:

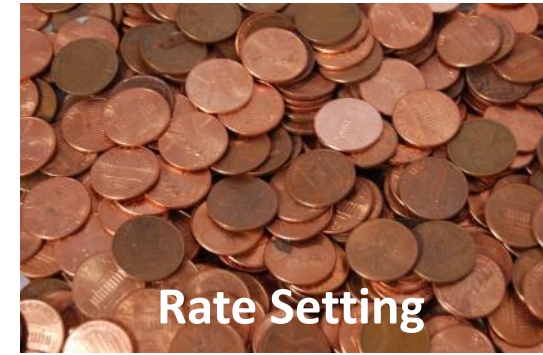
- 90% satisfied with reporting method

- 83% overall satisfied with the pilot
- 71% think a road charge is more fair than a gas tax
